RANDOM MOVE circled horses into the stretch, got up in in the final furlong then was caught late. PIRATE KING broke sharp to set the pace then was not quite good enough late. PERSONAL EDGE loomed boldly through the stretch then lacked the needed closing kick. TOBY THE COAL MAN moved closer around the far turn then gave way grudgingly. SEA OF LIQUIDITY prompted the pace then faded in the drive. GREAT HALO was well placed racing close up along the inside then weakened drive. VEER lacked a rally. CHANGING FUNDS showed little.
