BABY BOOK made a run leaving the turn and finished willingly to close the gap. SAHMKINDAWONDERFUL advanced along the inside on the turn then responded well in the final furlong. DELIVER THE ROSES was outrun to the stretch then finished with good energy to close the gap. GOLDEN MOON lacked the needed rally. BOLD OUTLOOK dueled for the early lead two abreast, got out around the turn then weakened in the drive. ONE FIT BABY showed early speed outside rivals then tired. Portable inner rail set at 25 feet.
