UNCLE HARRY lacked the needed rally. RICHIE THE THIEF vied for the early along the inside then weakened in the drive. VERSAILLES FOX showed little. AUSTERITY MEASURES got out around the first turn, vied for the lead two wide then tired. PROUD DADDY tired.
