SKIN DEEP stalked the early pace under patient handling, bid through the second turn to gain a clear lead, turned back a challenge from DANDY DULCE out of the second turn to mid stretch to regain a clear lead then just lasted late. BON PLACE was never far back, was blocked behind rivals through the second turn then swung outside for clear racing room and closed willingly late to just miss. DANDY DULCE made a three wide middle move to challenge the winner, loomed a threat to inside the final furlong then hung late. JELLY FISH made a middle move to be in contention out of the second turn then gave way under pressure. BUCKAROO'S JAZZ was stoutly rated inside for five furlongs then faded. LOST JUDGEMENT set the pace to the second turn then weakened. FABLIAN showed little.
