Footnotes

IMORATAS unhurried early, made a three wide middle move to contention then rallied past the leaders from the outside through the furlong grounds to win going away. BREAKING UP chased the leader early, bid outside that one after five furlongs, shook clear a furlong out but was no match for the winner while besting the rest. MUCKRAKER (IRE) set a moderate pace early, resisted to the final furlong then weakened. STRONG INDIAN was well placed outside to the stretch then gave way. POWER KEY raced evenly. FRANKS A COMING was no factor. CLAWER showed little. J DOUBLE F was through after a half. LONGSHORE stopped.
