OUT OF TUNE quickly to the front to set all the pace and held sway under steady pressure through the stretch. CRYSTAL BEACH, well placed just off the pace near the inside, finished well to gradually close the gap. ROBERTO'S GIRL moved up three wide to loom a threat on the far turn then faded in the final furlong. DELLA STREET, well placed close to the pace, moved up menacingly on the far turn then faded in the drive. TIA'S MISS lacked the needed rally. LUNAR'S PRISSY showed little. MISS QUACKERS was outrun. SILVERLADO tired from her early effort and was eased through the stretch.
