FAST JOE was unhurried early, looped rivals four wide moving to contention the rallied past the leader leaving the furlong grounds. DR. SKIP was boxed and forced to wait for racing room through the second turn, found room from between rivals to drive clear in the stretch only to weakened late. TOP BUSINESS raced well placed early, bid after five furlongs then flattened out. WISE CROSSING chased early, bid in the second turn then gave way. RECKLESS RUNNER set a quick pace early then faded. SAIGON STORY raced evenly. DUENDE was no factor. ULTIMATE X. stopped. TRONDOR (ARG) steadied in the first turn then lost contact with the field.
