MAID GUINEVERE vied for the lead between rivals early, eased back through the turn then angled outside and came back on again to challenged through the furlong grounds and be up in the late stages under brisk handling. FELLOWSHIP ROAD dueled three wide from the outset, gained a short advantage into the stretch then continued well through a long drive before just hanging late while best of the rest. VIBRANT raced boxed inside to upper stretch then failed to respond when room opened up between rivals in the furlong grounds. WESTERN TIMES raced wide advancing through the turn then flattened out. HILL BRAE failed to menace. ANNETTE'S JET was no factor. MY FAVORITE MISS was used up disputing the pace inside.
