MARGEISFORTHEBIRDS settled off the pace off the rail, bid for the lead passing the three eighths pole and kept alert through the lane. KATE C. rated off the pace off the rail, eased three wide into the lane and finished well to chase the winner home. TRULY DIVINE exchanged contact with Rose O'Tour leaving the gate, settled unhurriedly inside, eased out making her bid leaving the quarter pole and finished evenly outside. KANSAS KITTY stalked the pace inside, contested the turn but weakened in the stretch. PHAT DREAM showed no speed toward the outside. ROSE O'TOUR exchanged contact with Truly Divine at the start, rated the pace off the rail then gave way nearing the quarter pole. GO GLORY GO was outrun.
