NASHLY'S VOW broke sharp and saved ground setting the pace then was headed in midstretch and came back gamely in the final furlong. MARATAYA'S TUNE prompted the pace racing two abreast, loomed boldly through the stretch then was not quite good enough. STARRY was unhurried early then responded well in the drive to gain the show. ARCHERETTE was forwardly placed but lacked the needed rally and finished best of the others. CIRCLEOFINFLUENCE could gain little. CITY AT DAWN broke alertly to be forwardly placed saving ground then weakened. THE TEA CUPS showed little. FOUNDATION was no factor. EPHYRA was through early.
