DEVILISH BERTI rated close four wide on the backstretch, contested a slight lead two deep through the turn and dug in from the head of the lane to edge away the final furlong. TIPSY SAINT rated close inside, eased three wide making his bid toward the quarter pole then finished well in the duel for place. R B HIGHER GROUND rated a slim lead two deep, contested the rail through the turn and finished evenly while yielding the win then nipped from place at the wire. CLASSIC ATTIRE rated off the pace widest, bid from the five sixteenths pole and finished evenly. TIMEOUTFORTHEJUDGE stalked the pace about the three path, angled out making a bid approaching the turn then leveled off in the lane. MORE TO THE POINT showed no speed off the rail. NOT UP FOR LOVE was never a factor.
