Footnotes

HUDSON STEELE rated a clear lead inside, was pressured toward the quarter pole, widened into the lane and relaxed the final sixteenth. MR. BRISTOL settled close off the rail after lunging from the gate, lacked room into the final turn, eased four wide leaving the quarter pole, came in midstretch and leveled off from there. OUR COMMANDER stumbled breaking inward, settled off the pace about the four path, started his bid into the final turn then lost ground weakening in the lane. GOLD MEDALLION stalked the pace two deep, bid from the quarter pole but weakened while being shuffled back midstretch. BACH came away a step slow, settled well back off the rail and had no rally. SHILOH'S PRIDE rated off the pace five wide on the backstretch, gave chase into the final turn but showed no further response. CHEROKEE EMPIRE rated just off the pace inside, picked up the chase into the final turn then weakened soon after.
