CAMELLA stalked the early leaders in hand, bid three wide after six furlongs to challenge for the lead then slowly drew clear in the late stages after being tapped lightly with the whip turned down on the right flank. SHARP APPLE was bumped at the start by CAVEAT'S SHOT, pressed the early leader in hand, gained a short lead into the second turn, couldn't withstand the winner' challenge but saved the place late. CAVEAT'S SHOT bore out and bumped SHARP APPLE at the break, was void of speed to the stretch then was gaining some late three wide. ABSOLUTELY QUEENIE set a slow pace for six furlongs then gave way. CHASING STARS saved ground, was run into a switch by CAVEAT'S SHOT at the quarter pole then failed to gain once clear. The portable inner rail was set at zero feet.
