DAVIDS LITTLE BOY was unhurried early, looped four wide through the second turn moving to contention then rallied past the leader through the furlong grounds to be along in time. CLEAN ENERGY vied for the lead from the outset, gained a clear advantage in the second turn but weakened in the drive while saving the place. TRAVISION chased early, bid out of the second turn to be a threat a furlong out but weakened late. NOTADREAM was well placed but lacked a strong late response. SEATTLE ALLEY was well placed for six furlongs then gave way. FRANKS A COMING was no factor. LOVE THE CASH duelled for five furlongs then faded. RUBBER DUCKIE trailed.
