DONALD'S PRIDE made a middle move after five furlongs, angled to the middle of the track to challenge for and gain the lead in the furlong grounds then bore out under left hand pressure, carrying. COUNTRY BE GOLD also made a middle move, fanned four wide out of the second turn then was challenging outside leaving the furlong marker when carried out by the winner then hung late while best of the rest. LYRACIST unhurried early, also made a middle move then lodged a mild rally. BADA BAM BADA BOOM set a fast pace to mid stretch then weakened. IRONTON was steadied inside early while being hustled along, altered course outside to press the issue to the stretch then weakened. DISTINCT VISION was through early. Following a claim of foul by the rider of COUNTRY BE GOLD, DONALD'S PRIDE was disqualified and placed second for interference in the stretch.
