BRAVE TIGER allowed to settle outside, advanced on the final turn, reached the front in the stretch and drew away. CLASSICAL CLOSING stumbled badly at the start, dropped far back then closed well too late. EXCELLENT SOLDIER pursued the loose pacesetter while in hand, led on the final turn then weakened. BIDHAM moved clear early but was finished after five furlongs. SPRIDAL saved ground off the pace and gave way. GOING FOR GOLD was always far behind. SHOW US RYAN prompted the pace briefly then stopped.
