DANGEROUS RIDGE, prominent from the outset, closed determinedly along the inside and drove to the front late. OCCULT was outrun early then closed between rivals and finished gamely to get up for second. DICE AND SLICE broke sharp, dueled for the lead along the inside and held on gamely. SWISSLE STICK, away in good order, loomed boldly through the stretch but lacked the needed late kick. SAFE FROM HARM, never far back, finished willingly outside rivals. MAJOR PARKER was bumped at the start then lacked the needed rally. MARIGOT RED lacked a solid rally. SPECIAL FORCES was outrun. MEGABROOK dueled for the lead two wide and weakened in the drive. Portable inner rail set at 15 feet.
