FORT DENMARK, unhurried off the rail, bid three wide into the final turn, dueled to the lead in the upper stretch, inched clear a furlong out then kept alert to widen. CALBO stalked the pace off the rail, advanced to the lead approaching the final turn, moved clear from the five sixteenths pole, dueled while losing ground into the lane then yielded to the winner while proving second best. EL TAJIN raced clear for position inside, rated the pace on the backstretch, picked up the chase nearing the final turn then faded in the lane. CAPTAIN OF MY SOUL and BOSTON WEST END were outrun. TOOLES RETURN gave chase while off the rail but never factored. FLEET D' MAISON came away awkwardly and was outrun.
