**Footnotes**

BOW TIE raced close up along the inside rail and closed determinedly in the final furlong to get up just in time. CIRCUS, well placed close to the pace, moved to the lead with a three wide bid on the far turn and drew off then was caught late. MAIN RULER was unhurried early then finished gamely to close the gap. BIG MINGUM was unhurried early, lodged his bid from the outside and closed well. HISTORY AHEAD was unhurried early then gained gradually in the stretch run. SPANISH COUNTRY moved up between horses on the far turn then needed more. SNEAKY LOUIS raced close up outside horses then faded in the drive. WHY NOT JOHN moved to the inside when clear early to set the early pace then weakened. RICHIE THE THIEF prompted the pace for six furlongs then had little left. GONE ROGUE was through early.
