READY SET was away in good order then moved closer along the inside around the far turn, came out for the drive and ran down the leader late. HUGO broke sharp and saved ground setting the pace then fought it out gamely to the end. TYBALT moved closer around the far turn then finished willingly to close the gap. PICK SIX was unhurried early then rallied from the outside in the stretch. CRISTOBAL was unhurried early then failed to menace with a mild bid in the stretch. NICANOR broke alertly to race in close pursuit, edged closer into the far turn then weakened in the drive. CROW'S NEST prompted the early pace outside rivals then tired.
