LADY OF THE FUTURE, unhurried early, rallied around rivals on the far turn and was under a hard drive to run down ATRIAL FLUTTER and get up in time. ATRIAL FLUTTER broke alertly to dispute the pace two wide and just failed to last. NEW ECONOMY was bumped at the start, moved closer on the far turn and closed gamely between rivals. ARKAH was shuffled back after the start then closed gamely from the outside. SUPERFINES LUYEY got out at the start, saved ground disputing the pace and faded in the drive. MY ELOQUENT MISS, well placed within easy striking distance, lacked the needed rally. CRUISE ALONG was shuffled back at the start, saved ground racing within striking distance but lacked the needed rally. XTREME BID raced within striking distance but offered no response. RIZZI GIRL tired. Portable inner rail set out 25 feet.
