RUST TULLY was in tight at the break, recovered to make a wide middle move to contention through the turn then after looming a threat outside the winner late, hung while besting the rest. SEW SPARKLY was void of early speed, swung to the far outside after a half then was gaining ground late. URBAN LASS got through along the inside in the stretch with a mild rally. PICABO SKIER passed tiring rivals. SEA BREEZE MARCO stalked the leaders outside then came up empty. ENDLESS QUEST failed to menace. SHARON'S DELIGHT set the pace into the stretch then faltered late. GLOUCESTER STAGE was through after a half. STORMIN IN SEATTLE stopped, pulled up in apparent distress and was vanned off.
