Footnotes

CARSONALITY made an inside middle move, got through into the stretch then angled off the rail leaving the furlong marker to run down SPARKLING NUMBER in the final strides. SPARKLING NUMBER dueled inside to the stretch, drew off to mid stretch then just failed to last. TWICE AS SWEET pressed the pace four wide to the stretch then weakened. SKIP THE PRINT was taken up from between horses after the start, made a wide middle move to the stretch then was steadied again in upper stretch before finishing evenly. REVIVE dueled between rivals to the stretch then gave way. LEAH'S PROMISE checked after the start and again in the stretch. SO SOCIAL showed little. BRITTS BOUQUET was used up dueling to the stretch and stopped. The portable inner rail was set out 25 feet.
