SLIP AND DRIVE, unhurried early, was boxed along the inside rail on the far turn then moved through in upper stretch and won edging away. SLEEPLESS KNIGHT broke sharp to set the pace and held on well in the drive to save second. BAD DEBT prompted the pace then lacked the needed closing response. ROADHOG was unhurried early then responded well in the drive to close the gap. HOBORIDGE was away alertly to be forwardly placed and lacked the needed rally. BANDBOX prompted the pace to the stretch then faded in the drive. EVOLUTIONIST circled rivals on the far turn then lacked a further solid response. SAINT PIERRE was checked between rivals into the first turn.
