STAKES Kent Breeders' Cup S. Grade 3 - Thoroughbred

FOR THREE YEAR OLDS. By subscription of \$500 each, which shall accompany the nomination; \$2,000 to enter and \$2,500 to start. Supplemental nominations of \$6,000 will be accepted at time of entry and shall include all fees. \$500,000 Guaranteed *(includes \$100,000 from Breeders' Cup fund for cup nominees only). The host association's money to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Any Breeders' Cup fund monies not awarded reverts back to the fund. Weight; 122 lbs. Non-Winners of \$120,000 at a mile or over on the turf since July 1, allowed 2 lbs.; \$90,000 at a mile or over on the turf since May 1, 4 lbs.; \$45,000 at a mile or over on the turf since April 1, 6 lbs. (Maiden and Claiming races not considered in estimating allowances.) The winner to receive a trophy from Breeders' Cup Limited. Closed Saturday, August 18th, 2007 with 25 nominations. (If deemed inadvisable by management not to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at One Mile and One Eighth).

NOBIZ LIKE SHOBIZ, well placed close to the pace, rallied three wide around the far turn then loomed boldly a furlong out and was under strong handling to narrowly prevail. TWILIGHT METEOR was unhurried early and moved closer on the far turn then finished gamely to just miss getting up. STRIKE A DEAL raced just outside the leader, moved to the front leaving the far turn and gave way grudgingly in a good try. SUMMER DOLDRUMS, never far back, finished willingly outside rivals. SOLDIER'S DANCER was unhurried early then rallied outside rivals in the stretch. WHEELS UP AT NOON saved ground setting the pace and gave way grudgingly. STARVINSKY raced within striking distance and lacked the needed rally in the final furlong. RETURN THE MONEY showed early speed then weakened. ENCAUSTIC raced close up along the inside early then tired. Portable inner rail set at zero.
