HARROW LAND, unhurried, bid six wide into the final turn and gained steadily to get up the closing strides. ROGUE AGENT rated off the pace about the three path, drew to contention three wide nearing the quarter pole, dueled to the lead in the upper stretch, dropped back inside the eighth pole but dug in gamely to recover place the final strides. BALIAN stalked the pace off the rail on the backstretch, moved to the lead inside the three eighths pole, dueled with a slight disadvantage in the upper stretch, recovered slim control passing the eighth pole but was outfinished for both top spots in the closing strides. VILLAINAGE steadied early, settled unhurriedly toward mid track, bid into the final turn and finished evenly. CHANGING FUNDS, unhurried inside, was blocked at the heels of Certain Circles and Proudly Pyrite through most of the final turn, eased out for the drive and finished evenly outside. TERRIFIC TOM raced clear for position toward the rail, rated the pace to the final turn, contested the turn but gave way in the stretch. CERTAIN CIRCLES rated off the pace inside and showed no response on the final turn. PROUDLY PYRITE was through after half.
