COUNTRY DAY broke out making contact with No Colleen, rated a short lead inside, moved clear into the lane and was driven off from the eighth pole. READY TO CRUISE rated off the pace about the four path, had aim at the quarter pole and finished evenly in place. THE DARP came away awkwardly and inward to make contact with Biohazzard, was shuffled back toward the rail passing the five eighths pole, bid in the four path of the turn and finished evenly. BIOHAZZARD, pinched back at the start, settled outside on the backstretch, came through the turn six wide then had no rally. NO COLLEEN, bumped at the start, stayed with the pace two deep, pressured the winner while alternating for the lead on the turn, lugged inward pinching Austin Laviva Baby back nearing the eighth pole and gave way from there. AUSTIN LAVIVA BABY broke outward making contact with Biohazzard, picked up the chase inside, was pinched back on the rail approaching the eighth pole and lost all chance as a result. A stewards inquiry and subsequent claim of foul against the rider of No Colleen, lodged by the rider of Austin Laviva Baby, resulted in the former being disqualified from fifth to sixth.
