PRIVATE SLIP chased the leader under patient handling then ran down JOHNNY DOLLAR in the late stages under brisk pressure. JOHNNY DOLLAR broke sharp to gain the early lead, set a moderate pace under good rating then after drawing off a bit in the second turn, continued well to late and just failed to last. CROWD PLEASER stumbled at the break, was unhurried for six furlongs then fanned seven wide into the stretch and was gaining late. HOLDITHOLDITHOLDIT stalked the pace and was in striking position turning for home but lacked a strong late response. LORD GRILLO (ARG) was also well placed but failed to respond in the drive. HARDY'S HALO was void of speed for more than six furlongs, fanned widest of all in the stretch and gained some ground but too late. LITTLE GHAZI failed to menace. CYNICS BEWARE showed little. The portable inner rail was set at zero feet.
