FOR FILLIES AND MARES THREE YEARS OLD AND UPWARD WHICH HAVE NEVER WON FOUR RACES LIFETIME. No nomination fee. \$200 to enter and \$300 to start. Supplemental nominations of \$700 will be accepted at time of entry. \$55,000 Added, of which 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weights: three year olds, 120 lbs.; older, 123 lbs. Non-winners of a sweepstakes in 2002 allowed 3 lbs.; non-winners of \$30,000 since July 4, 5 lbs.; non-winners of \$18,000 since June 4, 8 lbs. (Maiden, claiming and starter races not considered in allowances.) Starters to pass the entry box by the usual time of closing. Field limited to 10 starters. Preference to horses that have accumulated the highest earnings in 2001-2002.

SAUVIGNON trailed to the stretch then closed gamely along the inside and got up in time in a sharp effort. LIBBY'S HALO prompted the pace and finished gamely to narrowly miss. WINGOVER, racing without hind shoes, closed strongly outside rivals. AMBER'S WAY vied for the lead from the outset and held on stubbornly to the end. SILLA, never far back, finished willingly between rivals. MAGGIE'S MISCHIEF moved up menacingly along the inside leaving the turn then needed more in the final furlong. MS WELL prompted the pace and faded in the final furlong. PAT'S POSSIBILITY failed to menace. ABSOLUTE JEWEL forced the pace to the stretch then weakened. WINGOVER's hind shoes were removed in the paddock when found to be not in compliance with Delaware Park's rules for shoes on the turf. Portable inner rail set at zero feet.
