PURE MARY looped rivals four wide in the second turn then lodged a mild rally in the drive. FRANSTEIN pressed the pace for five furlongs then weakened. SYLVIA'S BUTTERCUP set a moderate pace then faded. PICO CAT was no factor. RIPE PLUM was through after a half. ROCKABELLA SONG showed little.
