**Footnotes**

COUNTRY BE GOLD made a middle move after six furlongs, split rivals advancing out of the second turn, fanned six wide for the drive then ran down JUDGE'S CASE in the late stages. JUDGE'S CASE had a perfect stalking trip behind the first flight, bid three wide out of the second turn to gain a clear lead leaving the furlong grounds then hung late. INVENT was void of early speed, fanned eight wide out of the second turn then was gaining some ground late on the outside. QUIET MIKE made a middle move, bid between rivals in the furlong grounds then weakened. IDE RATHER raced evenly. CITY SHARPSTER dueled to mid stretch before giving way. BAG OF MISCHIEF dueled to near mid stretch then steadied while tiring. KERNAL K made a middle move to the stretch then was blocked and in tight through the final three sixteenths. DR. THUNDER dwelt at the break. MY MAN RYAN stopped.
