RUNSPASTUM was unhurried early then was blocked for a time from the three eighths pole to second turn, split rivals once in the second turn then again out of the second turn then ran past rivals leaving the furlong grounds to be along in time. AMERICAN PRINCE made a middle move to be in striking position out of the second turn, couldn't stay with the winner late but outfinished the rest under strong handling. CONFUCIUS SAY dueled for more than a half, drew clear and away a bit through the second turn then weakened in the final furlong. SMASHING BEAU stalked the pace inside for more than six furlongs, bid inside in the furlong grounds then gave way late. FOUR ALERT chased outside to the stretch then gave way. OMMADON raced evenly. MARCIANO showed little. BADA BAM BADA BOOM stopped.
