STRYKER moved up along the inside into the stretch then came out to run down the leader in the final furlong. KAFWAIN WEDGEHEART was prominent from the outset and finished willingly to close the gap. FOR ALL WHO CONGA, never far back, closed well in the final furlong for third. FUNDIT was outrun to the stretch then angled wide behind horses in upper stretch and closed but was too late. CALL ME NOW saved ground showing the way into the final furlong and weakened. G'DAY MATE failed to threaten. POLITICAL NONSENSE prompted the pace racing two wide, drifted out leaving the turn then was not pressured in the final furlong. FULLOFSON tired.
