MIRACULOUS MISS was off a step slow, was void of speed for a half, fanned five wide into the stretch then rallied past the leaders leaving the furlong grounds while ridden out. GILDED GOLD broke sharp, set a fast pace, drew off a bit leaving the turn but hung late while saving the place. COLI BEAR pressed the leader much of the way but was outkicked late. THATS OUR SONG angled in early, stalked behind the leader then got through along the rail to challenge in the furlong grounds but was also outfinished late. EBONY BREEZE angled out six wide then made up some ground outside late. MISS ELSIE raced evenly. HELLO LIBERTY was through after a half. HOT STORM stopped after a half.
