NOT SHEILA saved ground setting the pace and drew clear through the stretch under steady handling. ALLEN'S MS made a run around rivals on the turn then couldn't sustain her bid. SEBA GO GO broke alertly, prompted the pace then faded in the drive. LITTLE WILDER was well placed close to the pace but lacked a rally. OOMA failed to menace with a mild bid. TURN SILVER TOGOLD failed to threaten. SET AN EXAMPLE showed little. JACQUES RED GLOW showed early speed along the inside and tired. HAY HAY TESTAMONY pressed the early pace and tired. MONALINA tired.
