FRANCESCO PUNCH vied for the lead from the outset, shook clear on the backstretch then resisted gamely through a long drive and was all out to prevail while drifting in late. FARMA WAY JOHN raced close up, bid into the stretch, dueled through a long drive then just hung. TRAVELIN DREAM vied early, eased back off the lead, bid again inside in the drive but was outkicked late while steadying along the rail near the finish. NAVY BRASS stalked the pace, bid three wide into the stretch then flattened out. GAMBINE ROAD passed tiring rivals. KINGOFTHEHIGHCEES raced evenly. PERSONAL FIGHT failed to menace. MISTER BERNSTEIN trailed.
