### Footnotes

MY LUCA was unhurried early racing near the inside, swung out leaving the far turn to circle horses then ran down the leaders in deep stretch. DADDY LIKES THAT, never far back, finished willingly near the inside rail to get up late for second. HOLD TRUE was well placed racing close up along the inside and finished well. CONCORDE EXPRESS broke sharp to set the pace while saving ground and gave way grudgingly. SUDDEN CALM moved up outside rivals around the far turn then needed more. I AM AMERICAN was rank to rating racing in close pursuit of the leader then faded in the drive. GRAND MONARCH was well placed racing just off the pace then flattened out in the drive. STARS AND BOOTS ducked out at the start, was forwardly placed for six furlongs then weakened. TAKE AN OATH showed little. YULIANI PRIDE was through early.
