MARTITA SANGRITA was unhurried early then edged closer along the inside rail around the far turn, came out for the drive then ran down the pacesetter in the final 70 yards. ULTIMATE CLASS broke alertly, saved ground setting the pace and fought it out gamely to the end. MILLENNIA was well placed close to the pace and held on well in the drive for third. DIOSA INDIAN was well placed close to the pace and lacked the needed closing response. SLEWSVILLE was unhurried early then rallied mildly outside rivals in the stretch. CLARINET saved ground and lacked the needed rally. ABBY RULES lacked the needed rally. MON CHOU saved ground and failed to threaten.
