CLASSIC WILDCAT broke sharp to vie two wide then was under steady urging to draw clear. PERFECT DRIVE chased from the outset and responded well in the drive for second. DOUBLE HOLIDAY moved up outside rivals on the turn then closed for third. DRYFLY saved ground disputing the pace and faded in the final furlong. ROMAN BAY was outrun early then rallied mildly. MANHATTAN RIDGE failed to menace with a mild bid outside horses. BOOT THE BOSS was through early. WELL RESPECTED MAN saved ground to little avail. DRYDEN was outrun.
