SHOOKSTOWN ROAD was outrun early then ran down rivals in the final furlong for second. IKAN got in at the start then responded well in the drive to gain the show. UNTAMEABLE broke sharp to duel for the lead between horses then faded in the drive. TRIPP O STEEL dropped back between horses on the turn then was no threat. HAMMERING BUCKEYE dueled for the lead along the inside then tired. EL CHELERO showed early speed along the inside then tired.
