JOYFUL JACKIE was away alertly and well handled setting the pace while saving ground then was under steady handling to hold JUST A LITTLE JET safe through the stretch. JUST A LITTLE JET moved up menacingly completing six furlongs then lacked the needed closing response and finished second best. EBBY, never far back, made a run into the stretch and finished best of the others. VALLEY FLING raced close up early then lacked a rally. THIRD TIMES BETTER showed little. RAGING BEAUTY stalked the pace to the far turn then lacked a further response. ENCHANT prompted the early pace and tired. Portable inner rail set at 25 feet.
