RAINBOWS ARCH worked his way between horses around the far turn then ran down the leader in the final furlong. SILVER TIE AFFAIR was unhurried early then responded well in the drive to close the gap. CROWN THE CHIEF broke alertly and saved ground setting the pace then was not quite good enough. T. BONE PICKENS was well placed racing close up along the inside but lacked the needed closing bid. DITCH failed to seriously menace with a mild bid. FAPPY NEKIA lacked a solid rally. SPIRIT OF ST LOUIS was forwardly placed near the inside rail but lacked a rally. DJEDDAH failed to threaten.

GOING GOLD was forwardly placed to the stretch then flattened out. STOMPIN N BOPPIN raced in close pursuit for six furlongs then tired. ICELUS tired from his early effort. PAPA IM showed little.
