DANCIN' DIXIE CAT made a three wide middle move then rallied outside to run down the leader in the final strides. LOOKIN LEFT was extremely hard to load, delaying the start, chased the early leader, took over in the second turn then after drawing off a bit to mid stretch, just failed to last. BABYLON RICH stalked the pace into the stretch but failed to gain. BERNULLI was well placed out of the second turn but had no rally. MR. W. B. raced evenly. VICAR IN THE HOUSE was no factor. HUFF 'N HUGHES broke slow. BRINEY LAD led to the second turn then faded. SAINT OMEGA was rank and forced to take up into the first turn.
