FLASHY BULLET, never far back, finished well outside rivals to get up for third. BASCOM HALL prompted the pace racing two wide, moved to the lead into the far turn then gave way grudgingly. YES PAPI YES broke sharp and saved ground setting the pace then faded under pressure. MR GOOD raced within striking distance but lacked the needed rally. YESTERDAY'S STORY raced close up four abreast then flattened out in the drive. TREATY NOTICE showed little.
