PROHIBITION was unhurried early then moved up along the inside into the stretch and finished well to best the others. MANDOOb broke alertly to race in close pursuit then weakened in the drive. LAKE NONA lacked a rally. ETAR popped the gate doors just prior to the break then was outrun. SANDSHADES tired from his early effort. FRANKS A COMING showed little.
