SUPER NEKIA rushed to the lead from the inside early, set a solid pace then after drawing off a bit to mid stretch, held a safe margin late. OUT DRINKIN' was never far back then rallied outside to finish well while second best. MASS made an inside middle move then lodged a mild rally. URIEL'S SONS was well placed but failed to gain in the drive. SKYEBAY chased into the stretch then weakened. DUCH SHULTZ failed to menace. FORWARD PRESS chased to mid stretch then faded. DIAMOND STORM showed little. SIR OZ was through early.
