SHAMROGE stalked the pace then moved to the lead with a two wide bid after six furlongs and won going away. ALISA'S ENGINEER broke alertly to be forwardly placed and was no match for the winner. MY PIANO MAN was unhurried early then responded well in the drive to gain the show. SNAP IT, forwardly placed, lacked the needed rally. TIZSILK failed to threaten. UNCLE TODD saved ground setting pace for six furlongs then had little left. NINTH CLIENT was checked sharply on heels around much of the first turn. CODE NAME NOAH tired.
