SKIP, never far back, was under strong handling to run down rival for third. ROCKABY BAY raced close up along the inside then gave way grudgingly. STANDUP COMIC was forwardly placed outside horses then weakened. ALL THE BASES lacked a rally. DINNER IN ODEM reared at the start. INAUGURATION prompted the pace between rivals and tired. A stewards inquiry was conducted into the start.
