SHOCK LEADER was never far back, bid into the stretch then drew off late. CHOLLIE D was void of early speed, split rivals in the furlong grounds then was up for the place late. DOC CEBU made a middle move, fanned wide out of the second turn to be in striking distance but lacked a strong late response. GOTANAVIGATOR stalked the pace inside, got through along the inside to challenge in the furlong grounds then weakened. IL TORO D'ORO was well placed inside when forced to alter course to avoid the fallen rider then failed to gain when back in stride. GERMANICUS set a solid pace into the stretch then ran over the fallen rider in upper stretch. ECHOES OF THUNDER was through early. HAZELNUT EXPRESSO chased to the second turn then gave way. FLYIN HAWAIIAN L C was no factor. TO DARE IS TO DO stalked the pace early, bid three wide to gain the lead leaving the second turn then ducked in suddenly and went through the inner rail, unseating his rider. THERE WAS A STEWARDS INQUIRY CONDUCTED INTO THE INCIDENT IN THE STRETCH BEFORE THE RESULTS WERE DECLARED OFFICIAL.
