Supplemental nominations of \$750 will be accepted at time of entry and shall include all fees. \$50,000 Guaranteed, of which 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weight Three year olds 120 lbs., Older 123 lbs. Non-Winners of \$30,000 at a mile or over on the turf in 2013 allowed 3 lbs.; \$25,000 at a mile or over on the turf in 2013, 5 lbs. (Maiden and claiming races not considered in estimating allowances.) Closed on Saturday, September 14, 2013, with 38 Nominations. (If deemed inadvisable by management not to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at One Mile and One Sixteenth).

ADMIRAL PERRY moved up to engage for the lead after a half mile and fought it out gamely to the end. SLEEPLESS KNIGHT moved closer along the inside on the far turn then lacked the needed closing kick. SLIP AND DRIVE was well placed close to the pace and lacked the needed rally. MARGANO prompted the pace then faded in the drive.
